E-mail is their most important tool. It was broken. They needed it fixed yesterday.

The Situation

The client is an executive search firm that lives or dies by the availability of their email as well as the files that they store on local servers.

The infrastructure was failing. It was causing them issues nearly every day.

Staff members were spread out throughout the United States. A disrpution in a key communication tool was not an option

They knew it had to be fixed, and they knew they had already waited too long. But they did not know whether they should invest in infrastructure or plan a move to Office 365.

They also knew that upending the way their employees work would also be a disaster. The failing infrastructure was already a problem. They didn't need to replace one distraction with another.

The Solution
